

## ...FROM LA VILLA

Starting from La Villa, follow **trail No. 13**. From the locality of Cianins, continue on trail No. 13, which passes through several **picturesque farmhouses** such as Craciorara, Pescollderungg, and Castalta, to reach the Pasciantadù mountain hut. At the intersection, take **trail No. 7A**, which leads first to the beautiful **Lech Dlá Lé lake** and then directly to our refuge.

**Tip**: For those who do not want to return on foot, there is the option of taking the La Crusc 1 cable car, located just behind our refuge. In about 15 minutes, you will reach Badia, from where you can walk down to the main road to catch the bus to La Villa.

Parking the car in La Villa, follow trail No. 13 towards La Crusc, arriving at Cianins dessot, where trail no. 12 starts, initially quite steep. Once you reach the higher altitude and intersect trail no. 15, the path becomes very pleasant. At the intersection, continue trail No. 15, skirting the Sasso Croce massif. After about 2 hours of walking, you arrive at a fairy-tale place, the enchanting La Crusc Sanctuary. The church remains open daily for numerous tourists and pilgrims. During the summer, there are as many as eight processions from the village of Badia to the Santa Croce Sanctuary, along with other processions from various villages. To reach your destination, the Ütia Lé refuge, take trail No. 7. Walking time is about 20 minutes.

Tip: To lighten the descent, you can take the La Crusc 2 cable car, located just behind the trees 100 m below the La Crusc sanctuary, and comfortably reach our refuge in 5 minutes. From our refuge, the La Crusc 1 cable car departs, reaching Badia in about 15 minutes. From there, walk down to the main road to catch the bus to La Ila.
